**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Board of County Commissioners of Okaloosa County, Florida, will hold a public hearing to consider adopting an ordinance, the title and substance of said proposed ordinance being:

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A COUNTYWIDE LOCAL GOVERNMENT INFRASTRUCTURE SURTAX OF ONE-HALF PERCENT (0.5%) ON ALL AUTHORIZED TAXABLE TRANSACTIONS **OCCURING** WITHIN **OKALOOSA** COUNTY, AS AUTHORIZED BY SECTION 212.055(2), **EFFECTIVE FLORIDA** STATUTES, **BEGINNING** JANUARY 1, 2019, FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS; PROVIDING THAT IMPOSITION OF THE SURTAX SHALL BE CONTINGENT ON APPROVAL AT **COUNTYWIDE** REFERENDUM; **PROVIDING** DISTRIBUTION OF SURTAX REVENUES AMONG THE COUNTY AND THE SEVERAL MUNICIPALITIES IN THE COUNTY; PROVIDING BALLOT LANGUAGE AND DIRECTING THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS TO HOLD A COUNTYWIDE REFERENDUM ELECTION BY MAILED BALLOT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
