

Response to Bidder's Questions, Part 2
Access Control System Replacement
Northwest Florida Regional Airport
September 18, 2014

- 1) Question: Can we get a set of drawings?

Response: The security infrastructure shown on the as-built terminal drawings is part of the Sensitive Security Information (SSI) at the airport and cannot be released at this time.

- 2) Question: Can someone run the sysconfig.dat on the computer to tell us the parts information?

Response: This is also part of the SSI.

- 3) Question: Will an equivalent unified solution from one of the approved software providers be accepted?

Response: A response to this question was coordinated in the Response to Bidder's Questions dated September 16 and is currently available on the Okaloosa County Purchasing Department website.

- 4) Question: Is there going to be a walk-through to see the readers, controllers, boards, etc?

Response: The Owner provided a walk-through for potential bidders who requested a walk-through on Friday (9/12) and no further walk-throughs will be scheduled.

- 5) Question: Will the county make available the wire diagrams for the current access control system? If the airport can certify that the bio-readers are no further than 500' from the panel locations and the wire is good we can work with that.

Response: See response to Question 1 above regarding the availability of as-built drawings. Contractors shall assume that all bio-readers are no further than 500 ft from the panel locations and the wire is in good condition.
