1. PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM

- a. The public address system that enables the driver to address passengers inside the trolley shall be tested and placed in working order.
- b. Inside speakers shall be replaced as needed with waterproof speakers.

Additional Items to be Considered and Incorporated in the Okaloosa County Trolley Rehab/Overhaul Estimate

- 1. Exterior wiring condition, exterior fuse box corrosion, electrical relay and electrical connector corrosion.
- 2. Electrical devices, including exterior lighting, horn flashers, etc., stop working without warning.
- Re-engineer serpentine engine belt arrangement on bus 100. Belt will not stay in grooves as now situated.
- 4. Replace fuel tanks.
- 5. HVAC air distribution and volume for front windshield defrost and driver functions.
- 6. Replace rusty windshield wiper components.
- 7. Seals on roof top windows.
- 8. Front bumper corrosion.
- 9. Structural frame corrosion.
- 10. Corrosion on access doors and door frames on body.
- 11. Exterior paint.
- 12. Exterior decals.
- 13. Wheelchair lift functionality and safety features.
- 14. Body damage at lower front passenger entry door opening due to low ride height.
- 15. Exhaust outlet relocation.
