PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE BOARDING BRIDGES FOR THE DESTIN-FORT WALTON BEACH AIRPORT

This addendum is to answer the following:

1. It has been stated that another phase of conveyor equipment will be installed after this contract has been awarded. In order to perform maintenance on the future conveyor sections should we anticipate that additional labor in this bid or will there be a change order once the equipment is in place?

The old, original flat plate is the only item that should be included in this bid. The airport will amend the contract just prior to the warranty expiring. Should there be some unforeseen problem that is not covered by the warranty, a PO will be issued after the airport receives a quote for repairs.

2. General Scope of Work -3.3 – Does the airport have any equipment for use by the contractor? Such as a load bank, fork lifts or scissor lifts?

No, the successful bidder will have to supply all equipment listed.

3. General Scope of Work – 3.14 - The spec says that "the successful bidder will notify the airport in advance to schedule quarterly PM's".
For PM(s), does the airport require (4) Quarterly inspections or (2) Quarterly, (1) Semi-Annual and (1) Annual inspection?

Yes, it will be two quarterly inspections, one Semi-Annual Inspection and one Annual inspection.
