

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to Section 125.379 of the Florida Statutes, at 3:00 PM or soon thereafter on September 15, 2026 in the Commission Chambers on the first floor of the Okaloosa County Administration Building located at 1250 N Eglin Parkway in Shalimar, Florida, the Okaloosa County Board of County Commissioners will conduct a public hearing to receive public comments regarding the suitability of surplus County land for consideration of use for affordable housing. At the conclusion of the public hearing the Board of County Commissioners will vote whether to make one or more of the parcels on the list available for affordable housing, or may vote to retain all the parcels in County ownership.

The list of proposed properties and staff recommendation may be inspected by the public at the Offices of the County Commission located at Suite 100, Okaloosa County Administrative Building, 1250 N. Eglin Parkway, Shalimar, Florida 32579 and at Suite 302, 302 N. Wilson Street, Crestview, Florida 32536. Those offices can be contacted by telephone at 850-651-7105.
