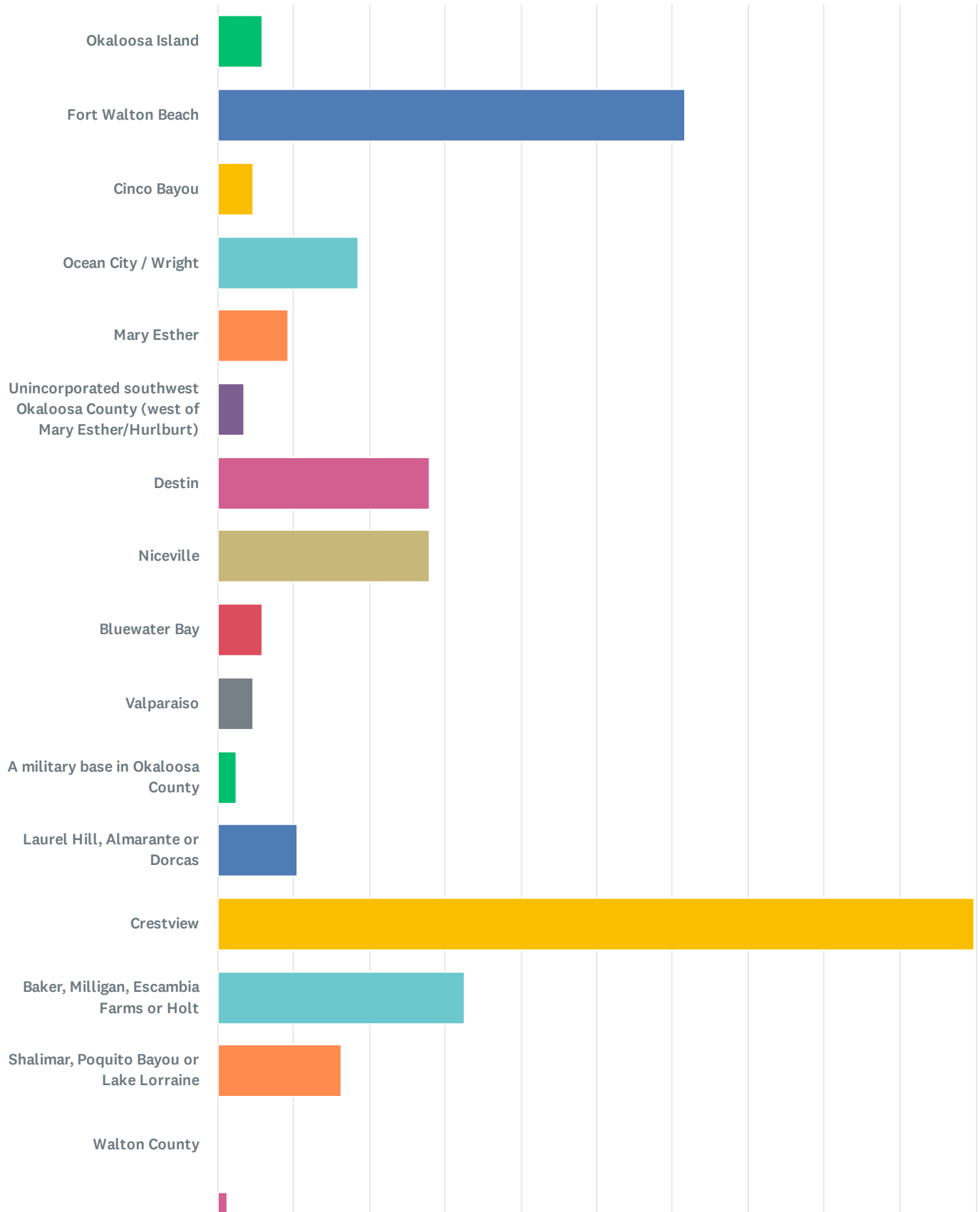
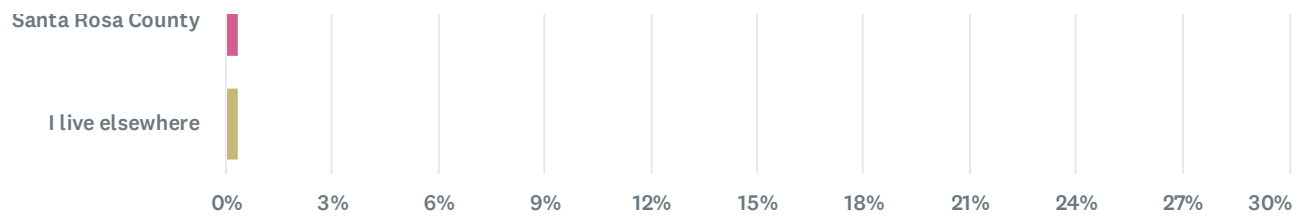

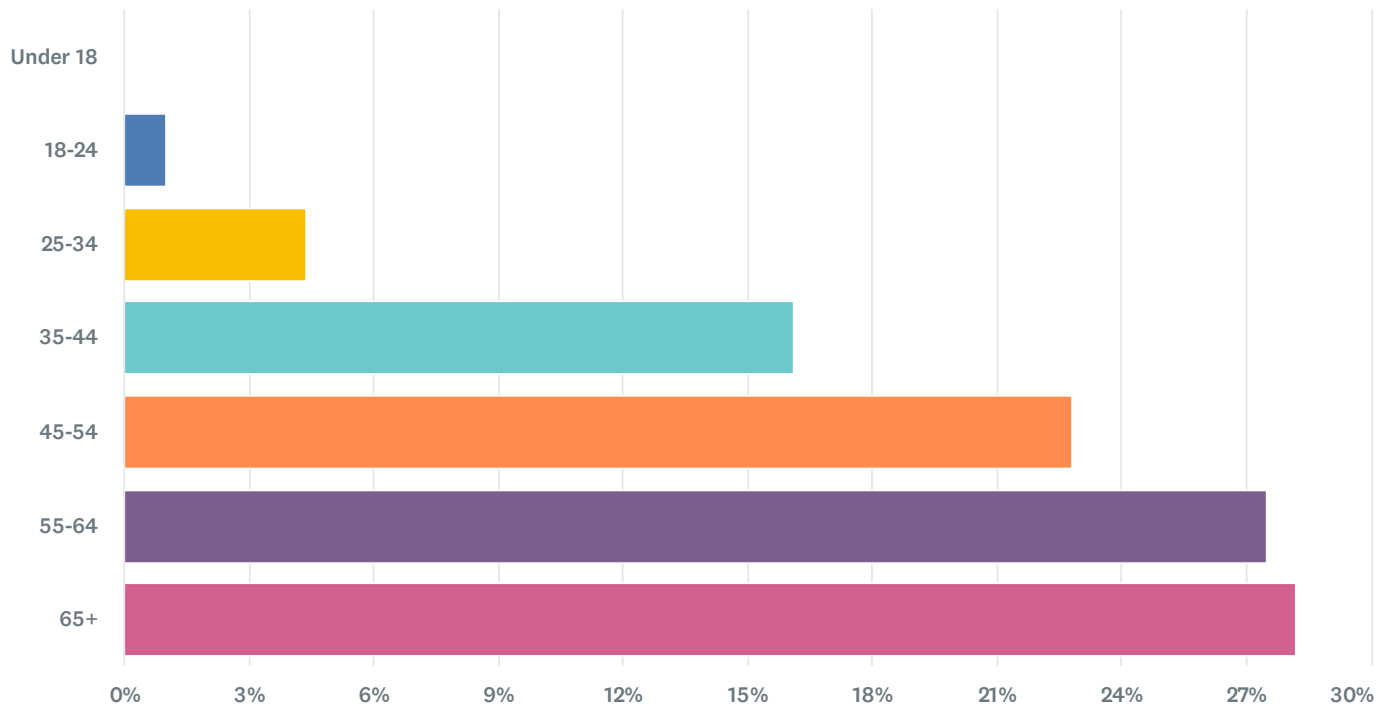
What area best describes the part of the County where you live?

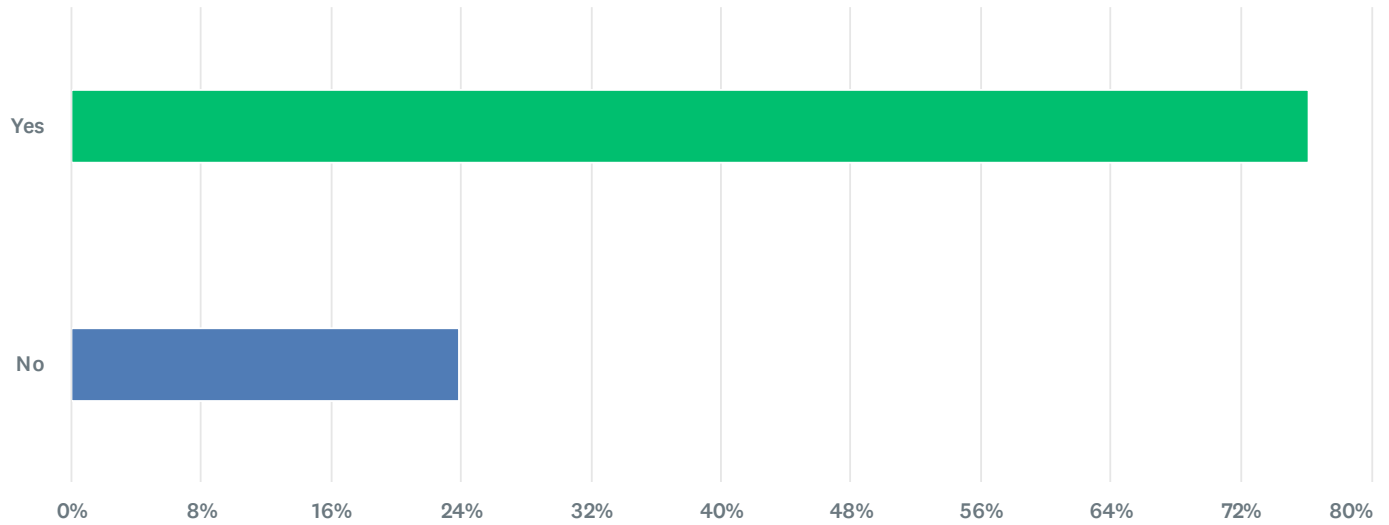

What is your age group?



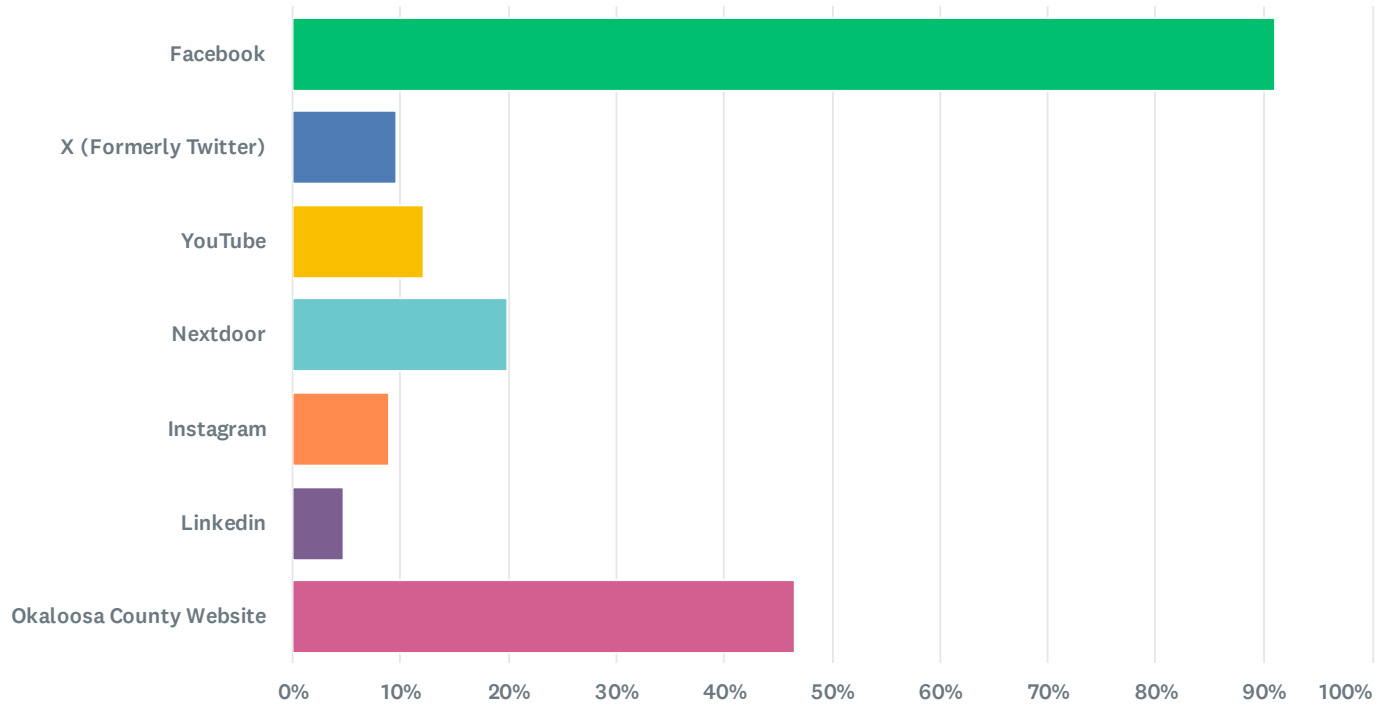

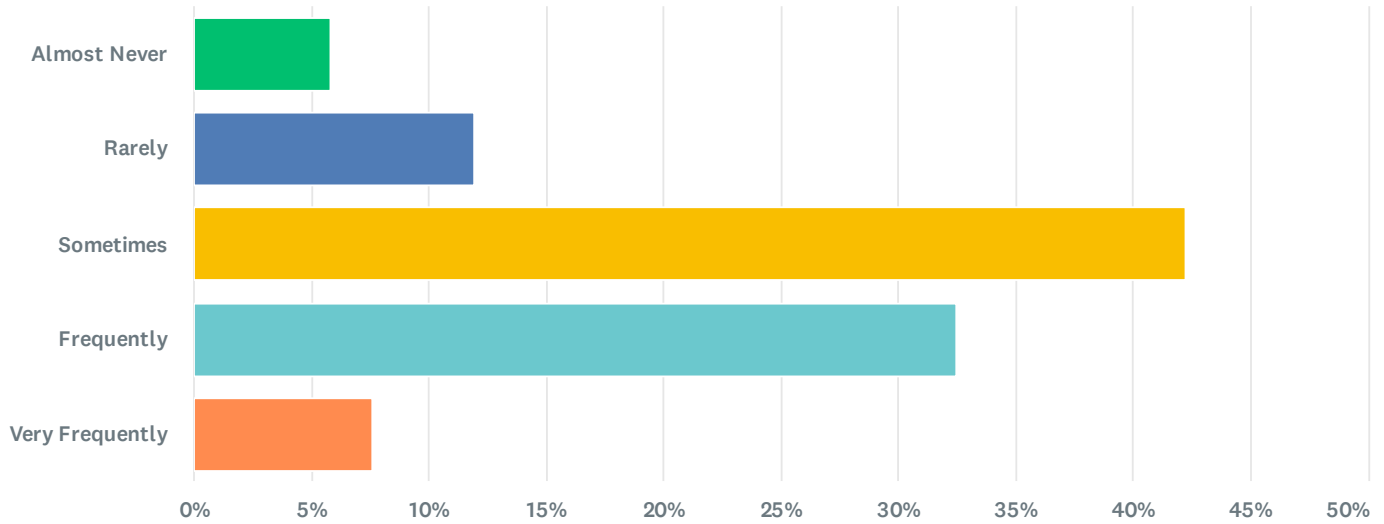

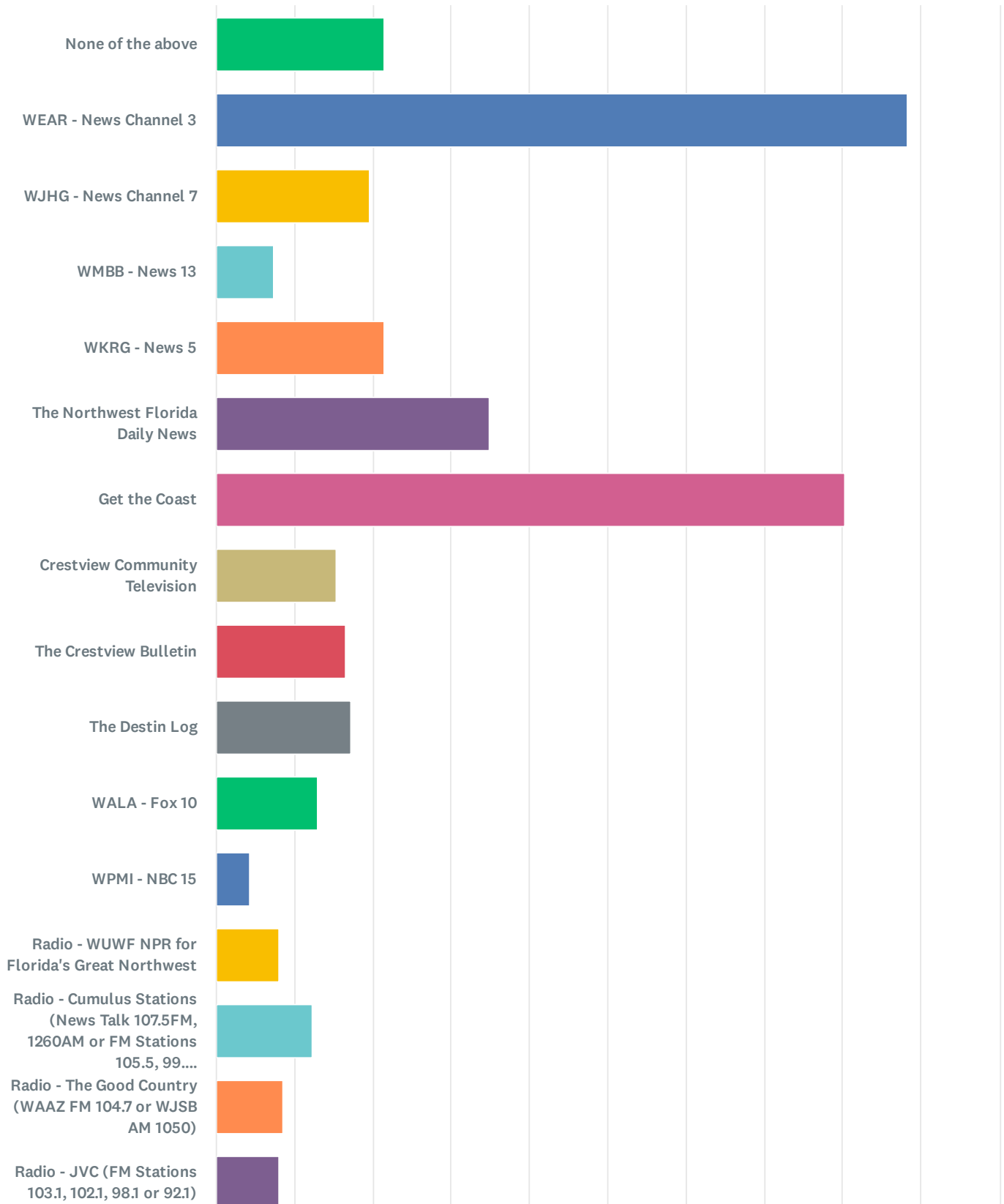

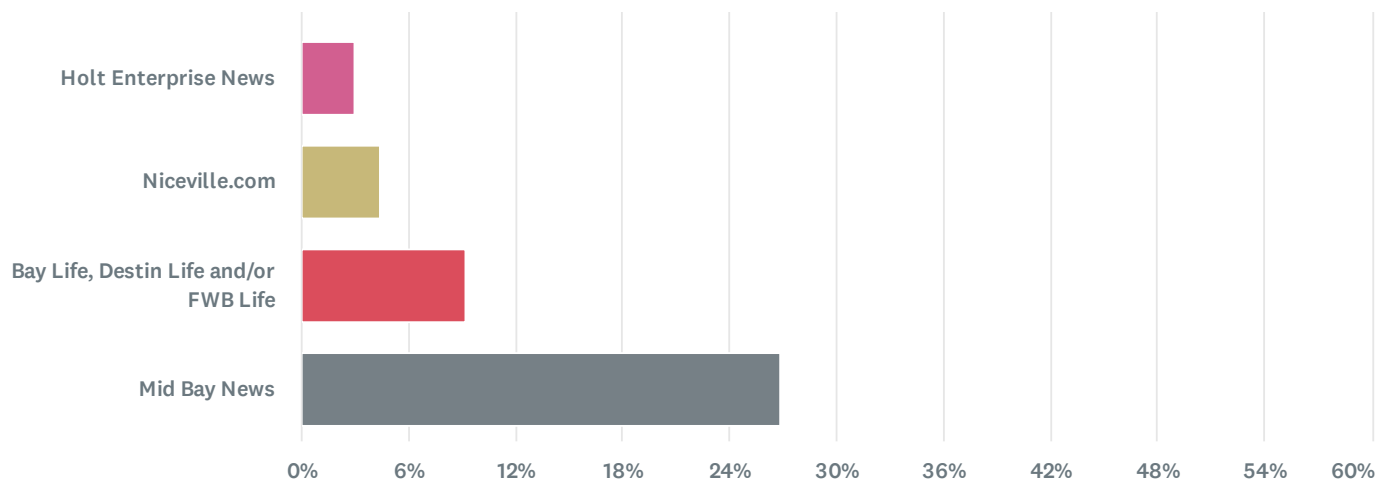

Where do you view Okaloosa County Commission meetings?



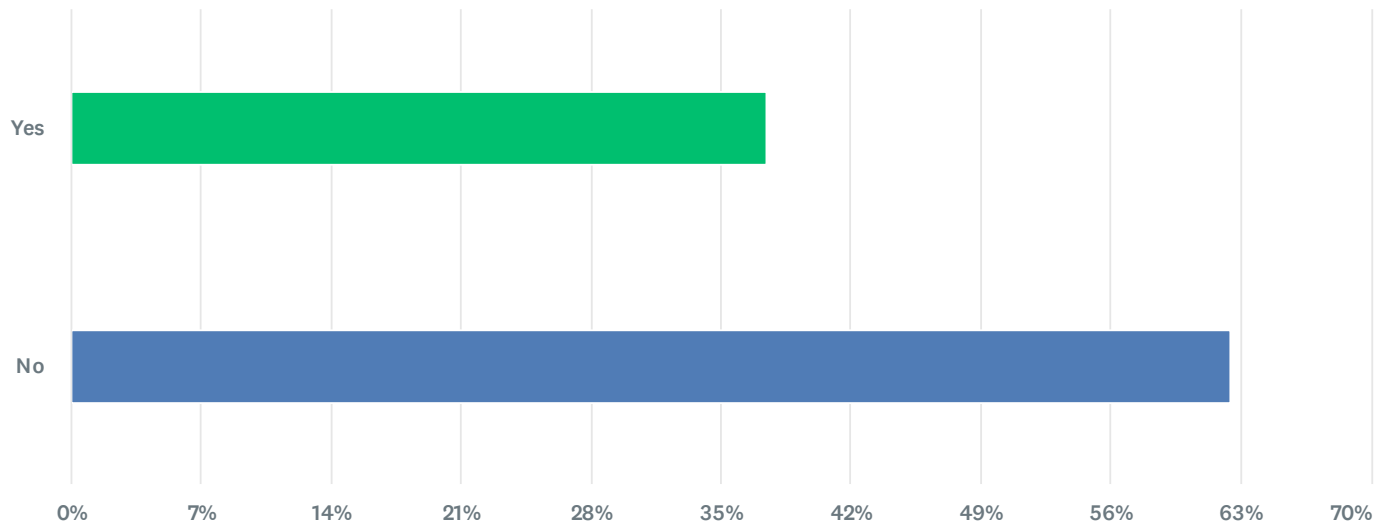

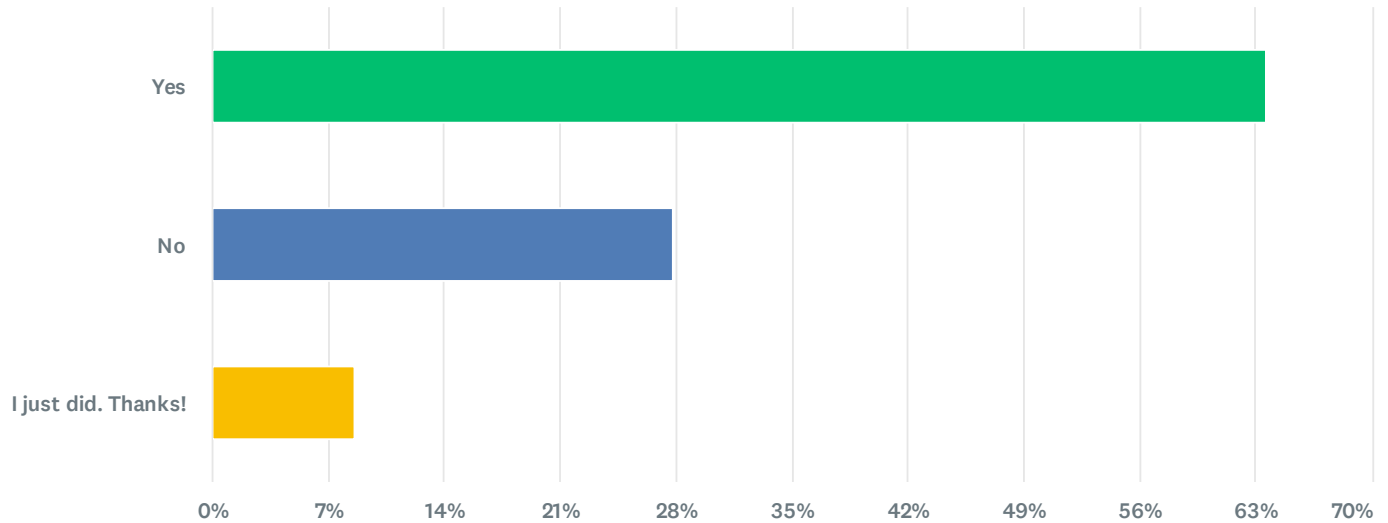

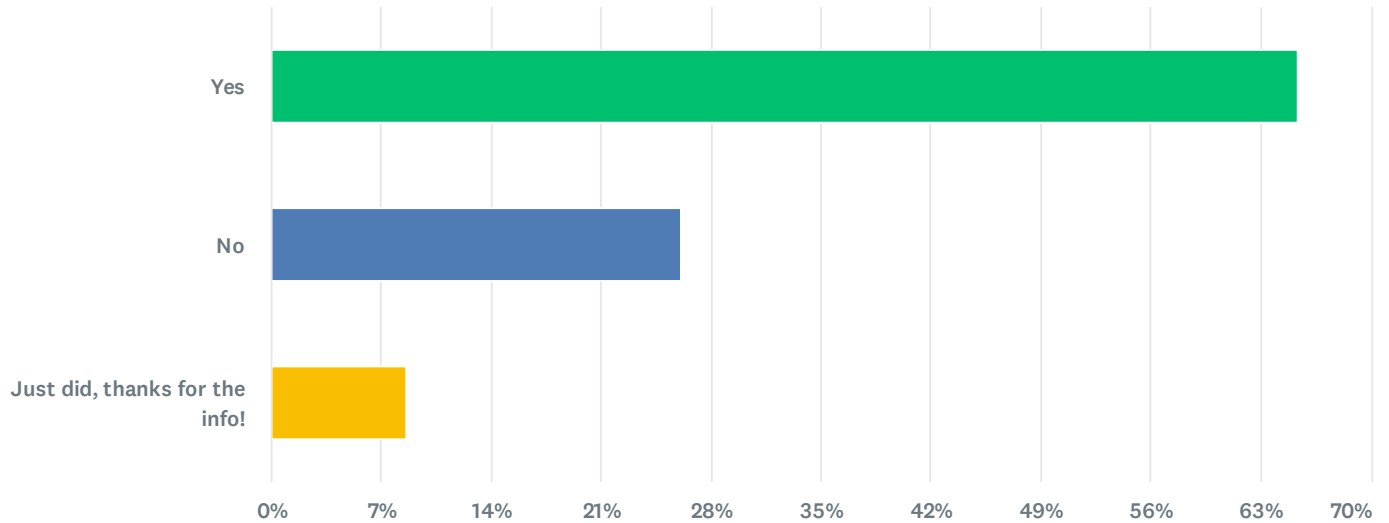

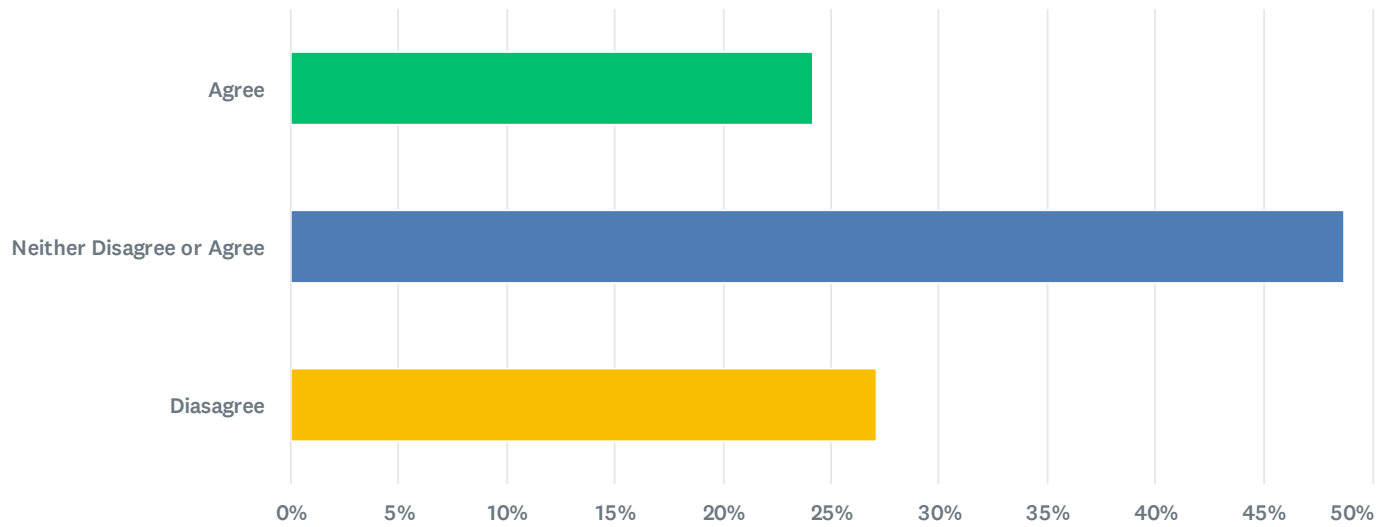

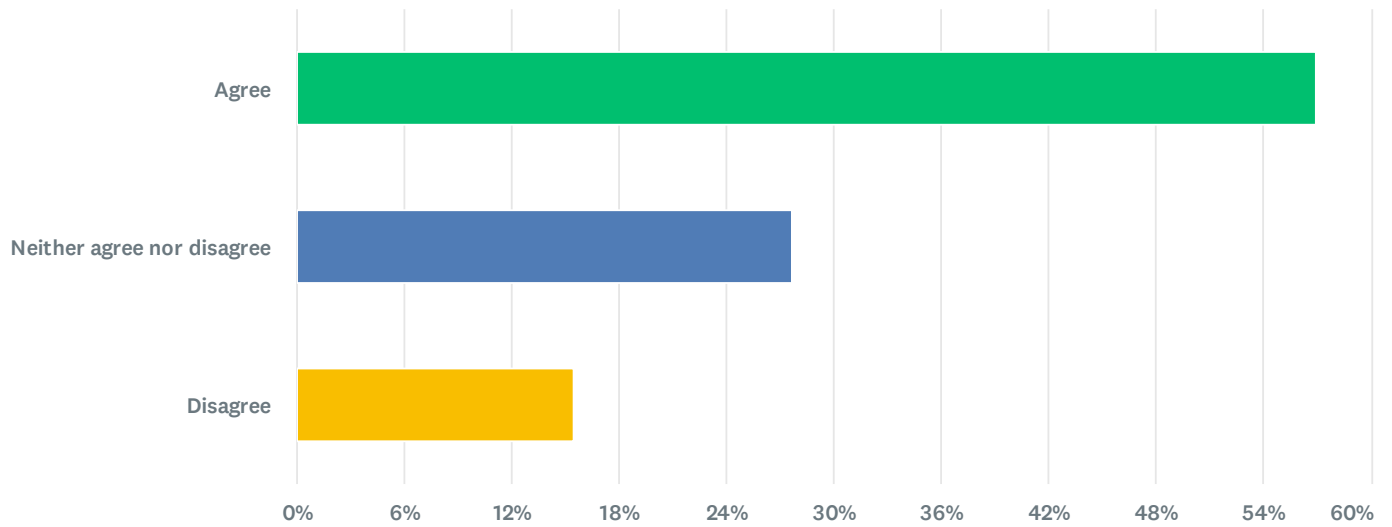

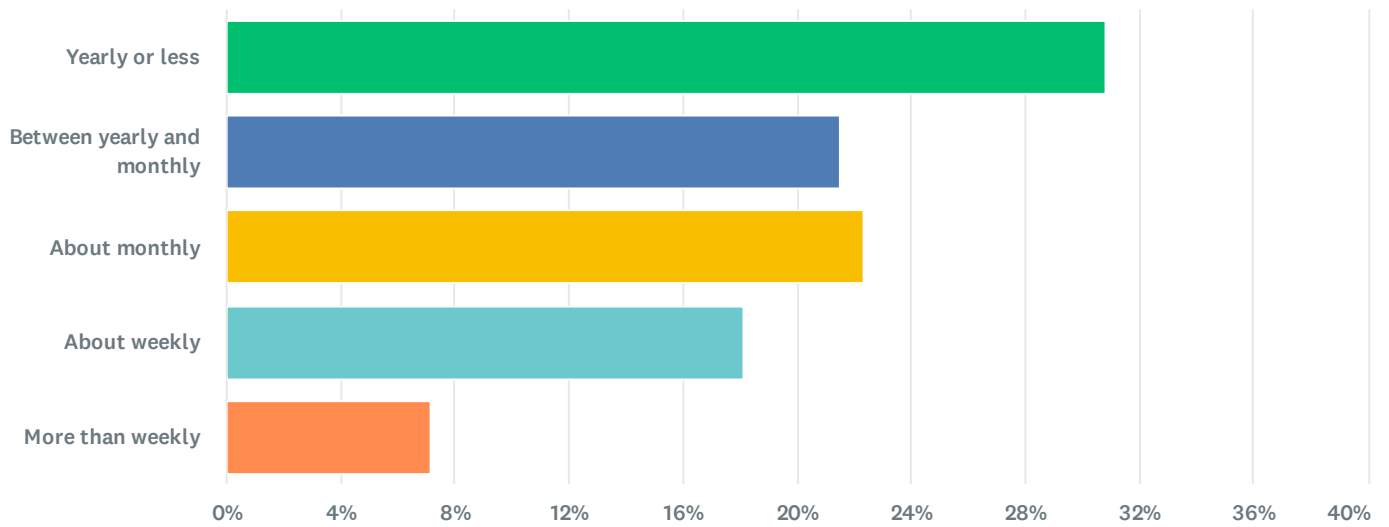

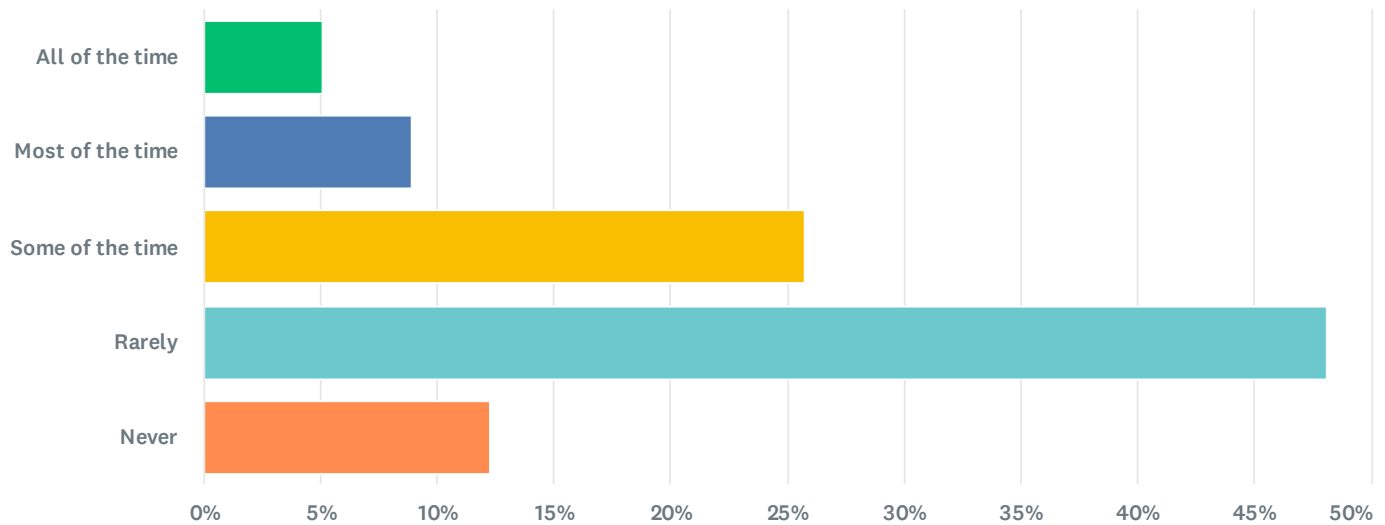

United States confirmed that modern, persistent digital tracking requires strict constitutional boundaries. Public safety must not demand the surrender of localized civil liberties.
