The Okaloosa County Airports hereby publishes a proposed overall goal for its Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program for FY 2022-FY 2024. The proposed overall three-year goal is 7.71% for all FAA-AIP funded projects for FY 2022-FY 2024, with a FY 2022 DBE goal of 7.30% for all FAA-AIP funded projects, a FY 2023 DBE goal of 8.00% for all FAA-AIP funded projects, and a FY 2024 DBE goal of 7.82% for all FAA-AIP funded projects. The methodology used in developing this goal is available for inspection at the office of Tracy Stage, A.A.E., Airports Director, Okaloosa County Airports System, 1701 State Road 85 North, Eglin Air Force Base, FL 32542, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 AM until 5:00 PM, or available at www.flyvps.com.
