Design, Construction and Furnishing of eight (8) moored surface buoys

This addendum is to provide a conference call-in number for the pre-proposal meeting scheduled for June 28, 2019 at 10:00 A.M. Please use the following information to call-in to the meeting if you are unable to attend. The meeting is **NOT** mandatory.

- 1. Are the depths verified and guaranteed? From the notes on sheet 2 of the draft construction drawings, the depths were obtained from NOAA Chart #11360. The depths have not been verified by the County and are not guaranteed.
- 2. The RFP states the life of the unit is expected to be 7 years. Is the responder required to warranty the FADs? From the ITN requirements: the buoy and mooring system shall be designed to withstand oceanographic conditions within the project area for the proposed design lifespan of approximately 3 to 7 plus years. The ITN does not include warranty requirements; however, the buoy system design shall be based on existing successful buoy and mooring system designs to provide high confidence of the system to meet the goals of the project. Additionally, the contractor(s) shall have sufficient experience to confidently estimate the anticipated buoy lifespan for the proposed conditions. The County will discuss anticipated design life and possibly warranty criteria with the selected contractor during the negotiation process.

Which one is the correct time? The proposals are due by August 1 at 2019? We will issue an addendum to correct the date on page 2.

4. What date is set for completion? The County will discuss anticipated manufacturing and construction/installation schedules with the selected contractor (s) during the negotiation process; however, the County anticipates the project being completed within 3-4 months of the final contract authorization.
